LAND TRANSFORMATION TEAM

2021

Welcome to the JGLAHC ! If you are reading this material, you have said ‘yes’ to God’s call and have been ordained by JGLAHC to lead a team of people in your region for liberating creation from the bondage of decay! These ‘land teams’ will affect all persons, places, and things in their regions through Love and forgiveness. We are dismantling the kingdom of ‘not-Love’ and releasing what our Father was thinking when He created us!

By now, you should have already attended a Level One training in your area hosted by JGLAHC and you should be ready to roll! If you have not, we highly encourage you to consider having one. The impartation given by God when the team is trained in *person* is liter-ally invaluable and irreplaceable. While this is not mandatory to starting a team, it is recommended that you begin scheduling one as soon as possible.

Teams have three basic actions: Praying for each other, praying over the land, and interceding for the team. If you are a part of a healing room you can incorporate praying for each other there, as long as you are using the Keys (Daily Bread, Light, Fully Forgiving) in a separate room during the prayer sessions. Be sure that you become familiar with integrating splinters, and with setting up individual accountability so your team is receiving the fullness of healing. It is so important to know that each team member is yielding to the Father’s will in daily portions through the Light of His Presence. Dismantle all demonic strongholds through forgiveness with the Blood of the Lamb and their spoken testimonies.

TEAM MEETINGS

Your first step is to organize your team and begin meeting IMMEDIATELY! The biggest mistake that teams make is to delay the first meeting. We recommend gathering all *of* the people who signed up at the Level One training as your first cut at a team list. These can participate in your first meeting and those thereafter. Most teams choose **weekly** meetings, which is highly recommended. Teams around the world have had great success with deciding on a meeting agenda that includes the following options:

1. Getting to each other. This can include quick introductions, or playing the ‘Numbers Game’ where each team member draws a number out of a hat. The leader then calls out each number and the team listens to the Lord for a description of that person in the spirit, not knowing their identity. They then speak out these descriptions for 1 to 2 minutes. A chronicler writes them down. After each number has been spoken about, each person reveals which number they are and the descriptions are re-read aloud. The team learns something about each other while growing in their ability to hear our Father’s voice!
- 2 Getting to know the material . Many teams review a portion of the material together in each meeting and then discuss what was learned. Either purchase the deluxe versions of the material, or use what is available.
3. Prepare for the first or next) mission. You can set up a specified email address if necessary. It is a very good idea to discuss missions in each meeting. Gather ‘jigsaw pieces’ each day from the Lord, then put them together in your team meetings to see God’s picture for you !

If you have not had a Level One training in your area, or if you want to grow your team beyond those who attended, we recommend spreading the word to others in your region who would be interested. Everyone who attended the training will have at least one person that they know that missed the training, but would be interested **in joining** the team. An option would be to schedule a special meeting for those who are new to the material, and then contact potential attendees via phone or email lists. Copies of the 'FOUNDATIONS' video are available by request and can be shown at these meetings, followed by Q&A with you and your existing team members.

FUNCTIONS

The primary function of every land team is to steward the Kingdom resources of your region by pursuing its portion of our Father's will done, each day. You will gather spiritual jigsaw puzzle pieces and lay them on the mat. Every team member has the privilege of gathering these. The Lord will reveal something to each person: a name, a place, a thought, a memory, a number that is repeatedly seen on a clock, street sign, on TV, etc. Each of these that the team feels are from the Lord should be considered by the team leader and held for the day when they fit with another piece. When these form a picture, you will know what the Lord is showing you to do.

Some pictures that the Lord gives us are for intercession. Although we declare that our land team meetings and everywhere we go are a 'no discernment zone for the enemy camp,' we sometimes have demonic schemes to dismantle. Herod will search for us by killing all boys age two years old or under (Matthew 2:16). Although we do not expect opposition against what the Lord is calling us to, but we are not surprised when it happens. The Lord will show you if there is anything to deal with. As always, someone needs to be forgiven, either a child of God who is praying their own will done instead of our Father's, or a lost child of God who casts a spell to curse the area (as examples).

Most pictures the Lord gives us are for land missions. You will need to organize your team into both Flight Crew(s) and Ground Control(s) so these can be handled, as lead by the Lord. Ground Control is responsible for receiving jigsaw puzzle pieces in preparation of the mission (during a 5 am to 7 am collective prayer time from home) or during the mission (either at home or gathered together in a common area). Your best Ground Control participants will have or grow into having the vulnerability to enter into the presence of the Lord, and the courage to speak out what they hear, regardless of how brazen, odd, or ridiculous it sounds.

Flight Crew is responsible for walking on the land that the Lord is calling us to liberate and release into destiny. The land we are called to can be a forest, mountain, ocean, river, or desert with a flat, steep, rocky, sandy or other dangerous surface. We can be sent to a downtown area with miles of asphalt roads or concrete sidewalks, stairs, or ramps. Flight Crew team members must be physically able to handle such conditions. When the Fresno team said YES the first formed, we were not ready, but the Lord gave us grace. Over time, we became ready!

Flight Crew consists of a crew chief, pilot (driver), navigator (GPS), chronicler (notes), photographer, and communications officer (texts between Flight Crew and Ground Control). Each responsibility can be handled by more than one person, except for the pilot, who can be the crew chief, but otherwise needs to concentrate on driving! Flight Crew is ultimately responsible for putting the pieces together to see the picture of who sinned, what sin, and what destiny to release. If your team (Flight Crew + Ground Control) has less than 10 people (a Hebrew Minyan), you will need Ground Control support from Fresno Office. Contact JGLAHC for assistance.

MISSIONS

Every mission begins and ends with 'currahee' - worship going in, worship going out. We like to sing a cappella or listen to CDs in the car. We highly recommend any CD by Christ Stewart (especially Listen To His Heartbeat), or Paul Pace (especially 'We Speak Life'). Really, any good worship music that is focused on our Father's heart will do!

Team leaders are urged to ensure that all 'old wine' is ultimately removed from the team. Avoid 'breaking off' anything (we dismantle roots!) or 'standing against' the enemy (we stand for the covenant!). In his 9th chapter, Daniel explained how he confessed his own sins (verse 20) and brought supplication for forgiveness on behalf of the entire nation of Israel. From this, the Lord gave Israel 70 weeks to stop sinning (verse 24). This process has become a method of healing the land ('identificational repentance') that did have value for a season, but the Lord has given us a better way! Instead, forgive as royal priests, hurling down the accuser with the Blood of the Lamb and the spoken testimony (purified, redeemed, and restored back to God). The memory of these ancient and current sins will be erased (Jeremiah 31:34) and the land cleansed!

Land can have significant hidden treasures (Isaiah 45:3) and storehouses (Job 38:22) buried for times of war. As the royal priests of God, we are the stewards of these resources (1 Chronicles 26:20), and the gatekeepers of each city (1 Chronicles 9:18). The resources include spiritual infusions of covenant, unity, provision, justice, peace, joy, etc. The gates of each region are like valves that release or receive resources to and from the area. Royal priests steward these resources by pursuing the area's portion of our Father's will done each day. We declare that the gates are open for Kingdom purposes, and off-limits to the enemy camp!!!

As you can imagine, the enemy wants these resources for the kingdom of 'not-Love,' and at the very least to ensure that the sons and daughters of God never use them for their Father's will done of Love. Some of these missions that the Lord sends us on can involve serious demonic structures of great power and authority that tie in to other regions or geographies within creation. In the past, this was an issue of authority. Now it is an issue of anointing. If you are the royal priests called to steward the Kingdom resources of the region, you have all authority. Yield to our Father's will done each day, and He will show you who to forgive and what blessing to release. Remember, we don't face demons. We face our Father with Love and forgive those whose sins gave evil the power and authority to bring **decay** to **our** regions!

Make absolutely certain that you have cleansed your team after each assignment. Not just Flight Crew, but the entire team! Pray and ask the Lord to seal the prayers that they are whole and complete. Forgive any person whose sins you came in contact with. Ask the Lord to refill your wineskins to overflowing! Also, post the angelic guard, rear and fore that there would be no ambushes or retaliation against the team. And finally, ask the Lord for miracles and testimonies! He wants to bless His people! Don't be afraid to seek, knock, and ask (Matthew 7:7).

PRAYING OVER EACH OTHER

Teams provide an environment for the participants to be liberated from the bondage of decay and released into their irrevocable callings as well. After all, we were created too, and are thus a part of creation! The most important thing is that each team member becomes a giver and receiver of Love. To this end, we must focus first on our Love for each other. We are not trying to 'fix' anyone, we are making room for the Lord to bring us into restoration. Each prayer session with our team members should rely on that person's daily portion of our Father's will done.

On occasion, we will find that that person's daily bread includes the integration of a wounded part of their soul, called a splinter. Splinters are always identified by the behavior that it embodies. We integrate the splinter by forgiving the part of our soul of that particular behavior, and washing it with the Blood of Jesus. Its testimony will be that it is purified and redeemed. Then the person you are praying for is restored back to the man or woman of God they were created to be. They are made *complete* and integrated, and the accuser is hurled down. For a list of known splinters please ask for a print out.

Once a splinter *is* integrated, the restored person can now finally repent of the behavior and receive the Blood of Jesus. The person will also need to forgive the person who wounded them in the first place, causing the trauma, rejection, abandonment, betrayal, or neglect that resulted in the splinter. This is also a good time to forgive all forefathers (1 Peter 1:18-19) whose sins are revealed in the Light that provide power and authority for the enemy to bring sin into the person's life (Numbers 14:18). Wash them with the Blood of Jesus and declare the testimony that the person being prayed for, and all forefathers / trespassers are purified, redeemed, and restored back to God. The accuser is then hurled down.

Land teams can be like a headquarters of heaven in your area. You are given great power and authority to overcome evil and release Love into an area. This does not necessarily mean that you have to dismiss your irrevocable calling / vision from God. If the Lord has called you to be a missionary to a foreign land, don't leave unless the Lord tells you to! Let the Keys become like rocket fuel for your missionary efforts! As you pursue daily bread, you will find that the Lord wants to capture the region He has sent you to with Love. He is your source of all things. Stay focused on daily bread of His will done, and He will meet your every need (Matthew 6:33)!

RESOURCES :

The wages of sin are death (Romans 6:23), but if you sin, you do not immediately die, you decay unto death. The serpent used this to deceive Eve, and ultimately Adam (Genesis 3:1-6). To this day Satan gets power- and authority (Luke 4:6) to bring decay to creation every time a person chooses selfishness (sins). According to Jesus, this was true before the cross (Luke 10:19) and after (Acts 26:17-18).

Terraforming is the process by *which* the sons and daughters of God liberate creation from the bondage of decay (Romans 8:19-21) and release creation into its irrevocable calling (Romans 11:29) through the impartation of authority given to us with the fulfillment of the prophecy of Revelation 1:2. Jesus promised that he would give us Keys to the Kingdom one day in the future (Matthew 16:19). When the church gave birth to its adulthood (Revelation 1:2:5), we were given these keys to usher creation into the completion of its covenant with the One who Loves us!

KEY ONE: Pursuing the portion of our Father's will done that He sets aside for us each day (Matthew 6:10-11). This includes revelation, discernment, Truth, freedom, deliverance, Healing, provision, and inheritance. **KEY TWO:** Asking the Lord to shine the Light of His presence that reveals the hidden sins (Psalm 90:8) that give Satan power over the world (Luke 4:6, Acts 26:18) to bring decay that leads to death (Romans 6:23), and makes us unclean (Lamentations 1:8). This is the same decay that creation is in bondage to (Romans 8:21).

KEY THREE: As Royal Priests (1 Peter 2:9) who are commissioned by Jesus and filled with the Holy Spirit, we then liberate creation from decay by forgiving the person that sinned (John 20:21-23) with the Blood of Jesus (Hebrews 9:22, Leviticus 17:11) and the word of our testimony, thus hurling down the accuser (Revelation 12:10-11). Our testimony is what the Blood of Jesus does for us: we are purified (1 John 1:7), redeemed (Ephesians 1:7) and restored back to God (Ephesians 2:13). The sins are now put to death (Colossians 3:5, 1 Peter 2:24).

KEY FOUR: Finally, we remove evil with the Authority of Jesus (Luke 10:19), tearing down their strongholds (2 Corinthians 10:4). Because the rights of the evil ones have been stripped, they leave no house (Matthew 12:44) to return to (Mark 9:25). We are able to command the evil ones not to eavesdrop on our Kingdom conversations and to require that all schemes of evil are disclosed, all as a fruit of forgiveness (2 Corinthians 2:10-11). We declare and release creation's irrevocable call of destiny into being to see our Father's will for Love accomplished!!!

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Exhibit A: Quick Steps

Getting Started

- Gather team and immerse together in Transformation materials. Many have done this in a study type format and found it to be very productive.
- Set up conference call times with Transformation team to ask questions as needed. Or email questions as needed.
- Begin Transformation application by praying for each other.
- Spend time getting to know each other and connected to each others spirits. *More than teams, we are family. "Seeing" each other is critical.*
- For land application, begin Transformation prayers on each others homes. If team has facility, make Transformation a priority.

Moving Forward

- Begin 'resting in' together for assignments.
- Establish Flight Crew and Ground Control teams for first assignment.
- Have 5-7 time before assignment.
- Gather for assignment. Though you may have a plan, be flexible and let Pappa lead.
- Currahee: Worship Going In. Worship Coming Out.
- After assignment completed, Flight Crew and Ground Control meet to recap.
- deal with any issues that arise such as physical manifestations that have not subsided or personal issues (such as splinters). *We never leave a teammate down! If we need to make Transformation appointment for each other before next assignments, we do.*
- *Chronicles of* team prepares recap with highlights and pictures. Include what was dismantled, blessings released, gates opened and fruit seen.
